

FEBS2020 Congress bursaries and Congress talks

FEBS2020 Congress bursaries

FEBS bursaries aim to help early-career researchers from outside the host country participate in a FEBS Congress when submitting an abstract to the event as first author.

For the 45th FEBS Congress, FEBS bursaries will cover the 'Young scientist' early bird registration fee of €250, and make a €400 contribution towards travel/accommodation.

Full details on eligibility and how to apply are on the FEBS bursaries page of the Congress website <https://2020.febscongress.org/> Note that FEBS bursaries are for early-career FEBS members studying for a PhD in a FEBS country, working as a postdoctoral scientist in a FEBS country, or working elsewhere after obtaining their PhD in a FEBS country. A 'FEBS member' is a member of one of the national biochemical and molecular biology societies that make up FEBS (its Constituent Societies); a 'FEBS country' is a country where there is a FEBS Constituent Society. The FEBS bursaries applications deadline is **March 5, 2020**.

Opportunity to present your work as a brief Congress talk

Oral slots are available at the 2020 FEBS Congress for presentation of research work selected from submitted abstracts.

Participants at the 45th FEBS Congress are encouraged to play an active part in the scientific discussion by submitting an abstract of their unpublished research to the event. From these submissions, participants reporting particularly interesting, significant or relevant research may be invited to contribute **Short Talks** integrated into the Symposia sessions. Additionally six **Speed Talk Sessions** will be organized covering all main scientific topics of the congress. Participants invited to Speed Talk Sessions will have an opportunity to present their results besides to their poster presentation also as a 5 min talk. Not only do these oral options provide great opportunities for those selected to gain recognition for their work, but also this approach helps present a range of new interesting findings from upcoming researchers to the Congress audience.


