

## Lecturer for the Area of Biomedicine (Professor Lector)



### What we're looking for

We are looking for a full-time lecturer (*Professor Lector*) for the area of Biomedicine with a PhD in fields related to biomedical sciences. The candidate will be required to:

- perform **key management tasks** related to the Degree in Biomedical Sciences: **quality aspects, study program, international mobility**.
- **teach subjects** related with biomedical research and human biology (e.g. Molecular and Cellular Pathology, Techniques for biomedical analysis, supervision of final Degree projects)
- Perform **research** in the areas related to Biomedicine in the Department of Basic Sciences: Neuroscience, Metabolism, Genetics or Cancer.

### Requirements

The candidate must have:

- **A PhD** obtained in a discipline related to the position.
- To be in possession of **AQU or ANECA (or similar) accreditation** (*Lector*) or to have sufficient merits to obtain such accreditation within the first year of employment.
- Previous **management duties experience** developed in academia.
- Proven record of effective **teaching experience**.
- Fluency in Catalan/Spanish. Oral and written proficiency in English.

The following aspects will be also positively valued:

- Ability to work both independently and as part of a team.
- Ability to get involved in one of the research lines in Biomedicine.
- Ability to supervise and guide undergraduate students in their research projects.
- Research experience (publications, research project participation)

### We offer

- A full-time contract in the Department of Basic Sciences (Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences) at UIC Barcelona (Health Sciences Campus, Sant Cugat del Vallès).
- A competitive salary based on the qualifications and experience of the candidate.
- Lab bench in a wet lab and use of the Department's scientific equipment.
- Start date: December 2023 (date is negotiable)
